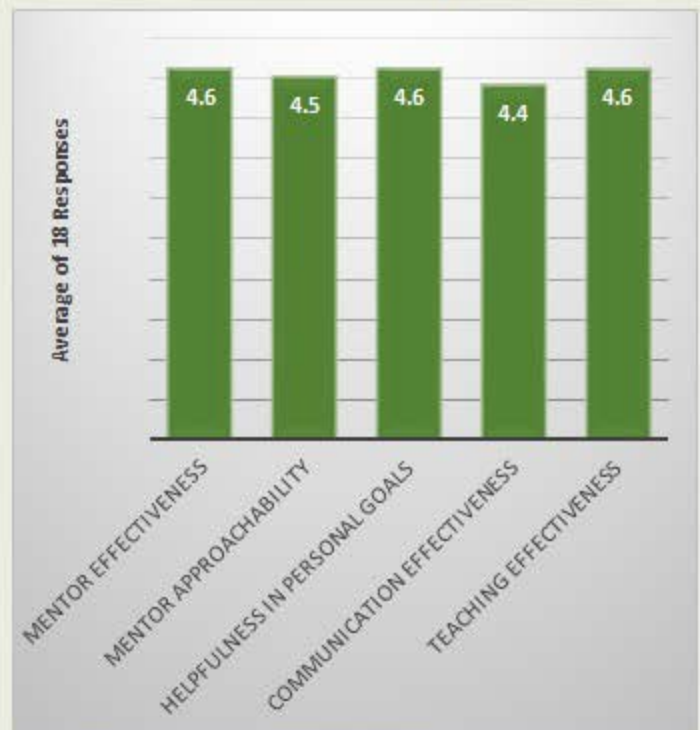


STUDENT ENGAGEMENT BASED ON # OF MEETINGS*
